

Attribution of Rights

Approach to the Rights of Students

How does the university handle inventions to which students have made contributions? Inventions made by undergraduate and graduate students belong to the student, as there is no employment relationship between students and the university. However, when it comes to inventions made under the guidance of an academic advisor, joint inventions made with an instructor, and inventions made using university facilities, the rights to obtain a patent are handled through an assignment contract concluded with the university, and compensation can be handled as it would be with an instructor.

権利の帰属

学生等の権利に対する考え方

学生等が関与した発明の取り扱い—学部の学生、大学院生等の発明は、学生と大学との間に雇用関係はなく、学生に帰属します。ただし、指導教員の下で行われた発明、教員との共同発明や大学の施設等を用いて行われた発明等は、その特許を受ける権利について大学と譲渡契約を交わし、補償金の取り扱いについては教員に準ずる扱いにすることができます。
